Just one hour from Dublin airport near the town of Castleblayney lies the hidden gem that is Concra Wood Golf Course. With spectacular views, the 18-hole championship course is set on 240 acres of dramatic wooded landscape that tilts down into the breath-taking Lough Muckno. Panoramic views stretch across the Monaghan Drumlins with the Cooley and Mourne Mountains to the east, and the Slieve Gullion and Mullyash Mountains to the north. Surrounded by the lake and its scattering of islands this awe inspiring setting is the perfect spot for a game of golf, fishing or walking.

The shape and flow of the golf course are perfectly complemented by the natural drumlins that roll across the countryside. This easy rhythm adds to the beauty of the course and its challenges, suitable for novices and high handicappers alike. Woods and trees stretch their way elegantly around the course and between holes rooting Concra Wood in its natural landscape. The View restaurant located at the highest point on the course offers local food with panoramic views of Monaghan scenery and beyond. **Highlights include:**
